HOW TO BUDGET

Because there are so many great builders from all over country and internationally who have been invited to be a part of our event, it is not financially feasible for us to underwrite any costs for travel or accommodations. Hotel rates this time of year range from \$130 for budget motels up to \$500 for luxury beachfront resorts. The earlier you book your accommodations, the better the rate you will receive. We encourage everyone to combine this event with an annual vacation and to arrive early or stay beyond the event dates to enjoy the area. If you are coming for the event only, you can find very nice accommodations nearby for around \$150-\$175 per night. Many include breakfast and there are 20-30 hotels within 5 miles of our venue.

Because you'll be on our campus most of the day on Saturday and Sunday, you'll likely be eating at our destination restaurant for at least a couple of meals while at the event. Your builder credentials will get you a 20% discount while dining with us. Our menu can be reviewed at www.occroadhouse.com/menus. We share a campus with Bert's Barracuda Harley Davidson dealership and you'll receive a \$50 gift card from Bert's good for retail merchandise (1) per builder registration, not per bike.

BIKE SHOW RULES, CLASSES AND CATEGORIES

All of the OCC Invitational Bike Show rules and information is enclosed. We encourage you to invite your customers to register and enter their bikes too, but remember only the bikes you enter in the Pro/Radical class of each division (up to 3) are eligible for cash awards. Again, the fee for individual owners registering a bike is \$30 per bike. While individuals registering a bike are NOT eligible for the cash prizes, they can certainly take home one of the 70+custom awards being presented.


COMMEMORATIVE BIKE SHOW INVITATION "COIN DISPLAY"

We hope these coins, while on display in your shop or office, serve a reminder to your customers that you are a recognized professional at the craft of custom bike building and a part of the OCC and OCC Road House family.

EXPO SPACE

Invited bike builders pay NO expo fees to participate. You also receive up to (3) complimentary bike entries into the bike show. Bike entry fees are \$30 per bike to the general public or individual bike owners.

Invited builders will receive a 14' X 11' space which will accommodate 3 bikes comfortably depending on their frame size and rake. Builders are responsible for bringing all tables, chairs and materials needed for their designated expo space. NO pop-up tents will be permitted as this creates inefficient spacing. If less space than the 14' X 11' area is utilized by any builder, we reserve the right to take back any unused space to accommodate more builders. We will work with you upon set-up to make sure everyone has adequate space balanced against getting everyone registered inside the venue.

Invited builders will be given premium covered space featured under our 20K sq ft Showcase Tent. If we have more demand for builder participation than space permits, we will assign preferred space based on the order of registrations and some late registrations may be subject to set-up in our outdoor space adjacent to the Builder's Showcase Tent. Non-builders and owner-bike entries will be positioned in this outdoor space around the builders showcase tent in the parking lot.

LOAD-IN SCHEDULE

The Builder Showcase Tent will be erected on Wednesday, May 3rd and it will be used for a huge truck show that evening. Each Wednesday we host the largest truck night in Florida and we have over 500 regulars that join us for a live country band and line dancing. Free line dance lessons are from 6:00 PM – 7:30 PM and the band and line dancing are from 7:30 PM to close. We encourage you to arrive early and see some of the baddest and most radical jacked-up trucks in Florida.

Invited Builders are also welcome to join us for our weekly Bike Night on Thursday, May 4th. We host the largest weekly bike night in Florida, Bert's Great American Bike Night, with live bands, vendors, over \$1,000 in prize giveaways and dozens of great activities from stunt shows and aerialists to big wheel races and ax throwing. If you arrive on Thursday, May 4th you WILL be permitted to load-in and set-up your expo space early on this day prior to 5:00 PM. After 5:00 PM we shift to vendor set-up and Bike Night preparations.

The OFFICIAL load-in and set-up day for invited builders is on Friday, May 5th from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM. You must be loaded in and set-up on Friday at 5:00 PM. If you arrive after 5:00 PM, just know and understand that we will close the gates for live bands performing as part of a ticketed

event and you will be required to load-in the following morning prior to 10:00 AM (the show starts at 11:00 AM Saturday). We will have parking attendants to help you navigate the parking lots and pedestrians all day Friday.

Once you are unloaded and set-up, you will keep your dedicated and secured expo space until the end of the event on Sunday evening. Builder Showcase Bikes won't move again until the show is over on Sunday evening. We do have 24-Hour Security, but we don't recommend leaving any loose articles of high value at your expo space while you are not present. You are permitted and encouraged to sell your merchandise from your expo space, but our Security personnel cannot be responsible for protecting your expo space until all patrons and builders have exited the Showcase Tent at the end of each day. They will not know who you are or what expo space belongs to you, so be mindful of this if you plan to leave any merchandise at your expo space unmonitored. Once the Showcase Tent is completely vacated, Security will be able to prevent anyone from re-entering until builders arrive the following morning. At a very minimum, we encourage you to cover or box-up your merch prior to leaving your expo space each day.

We also recommend that you watch the weather. If rain is eminent, the asphalt under the tent in some areas is subject to getting wet depending on how hard it rains, so you might want to lift up and secure any carpeting or materials being utilized that are placed on the ground.

There is no overnight vehicle or trailer parking permitted on property. Once you've unloaded and set-up is complete, we ask that all trailers be taken back to your hotel or VRBO and left there for the duration of the event to free-up our customer parking. Please don't bring trailers back on property once you've set-up, until of course the event is over and it's time to break-down and load-out.

BUILDER REGISTRATION

Registration must be completed online at www.occinvitational.com. Please complete all fields and select the correct division & class for each bike you'll be entering into the show. Please also enter all bike details and description fields so your bike(s) can be identified properly on our voting hand-outs. Again, preferred expo space will be based on the order in which builders have fully registered.

EVENT CONCIERGE
